Zulfa suggested that the SRC is mentioned during orientation lessons at the start of a semester. Chris supported this. Nisura and Michaela to start project.

7. Discussion theme -

7.1. Overview of the progress of the Learner Engagement and Partnership Strategy 2021–2023 – Michaela presented the strategy document.

- **7.2.** What are the priorities for students when it comes to student partnership and voice at Holmesglen for 2024 2026? Michaela expects the new document to come from collaboration between students and staff.
- 7.3. How should we survey the wider student community about their view and opinion on the Learner Engagement and Partnership Strategy? Magaly suggested engagement via Facebook and other Social Media platforms. How do we engender a sense of pride in attending Holmesglen? Could the Diploma of Community Service project be used to help student engagement (Sixuan/Michaela)? Magaly suggested to use the phrases "Be proud to be at Holmesglen" and "Build your perfect experience at Holmesglen", as easy for international students to follow.
- 7.4. How do we activate this conversation throughout the student's journey at Holmesglen? Watareka asked what incentives could be offered to students? Magaly suggested to show more alumni success stories on the website. Can we (Michaela) follow up and see if institute emails are getting out to most students?
- 7.5. Engaging with student digitally do students feel this is done well at Holmesglen? Nisura asked for more from the Holmesglen social media (SM) pages, and possibly to use BrightSpace to reach more students. Investigate running socials through media student classes. Check for consistent messaging across the different SM platforms.
